**Source:** The Alberta Society of Artists

**Eligibility:** Any 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> year student enrolled in a Fine Arts program at an

accredited post-secondary institution within Alberta. The applicants must be a full-time student and a resident of Alberta. Must not have previously been awarded a scholarship by the Alberta Society of Artists.

**Criteria:** Awarding the scholarship will be based on a combination of artistic merit,

innovation and creativity, and academic achievement.

**Value:** \$1000.00

**Quantity:** Two individual scholarships

**Selection:** By Blind Jury from the Alberta Society of Artists

Deadline: February 29, 2024 at 11:59pm MST

**Notification:** Recipients will be notified by email in March 2024

## **SUBMISSION**

Use the ASA Online Application form to provide Artist Contact information. (The majority of the information for the Scholarship MUST be submitted in PDF format).

## PDF Requirements:

- An artist resume or CV
- Up-to-date, unofficial transcript from a post-secondary institution. If recently transferred to a new institution, then provide a transcript from the previous institution as well.
- Artist Statement pertaining to the body of work submitted (200 words max.)
- 5 (five) artwork images, and the relevant information regarding each work depicted (title, year, medium, dimensions, etc.)

PDFs can be created using Adobe products (Adobe Acrobat, Illustrator, Indesign, Photoshop, etc.),
Document and Presentation Software (Word, Docs, Pages, PowerPoint, Slides, Keynote, etc - typically found under
"File" as either "Save As," "Export," or "Download"), Free/Paid Online Services such as Canva
(https://www.canva.com/), Soda PDF (https://online.sodapdf.com/), etc.
